Brief summary of the survey

As the survey showed, 50.9% students reported that 85-100% topics of the syllabus were covered in the class, and 63.7% students satisfied with the teacher preparation for the class. 64.9% students agreed that teachers always communicate effectively with the students. Moreover, 34.5% students opted excellent on teacher’s approach in the class. The Majority of the students (60.6%) reported that the internal evaluation process of the college had been always fair. Further, 37.8% students agreed that the performance in the assignment was discussed every time in the class. As 48.2% students opted, the teaching and mentoring process of the college was very well, and 50% students agreed that the institute provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. As pointed by 55.5% students, every time teachers inform students about expected competencies, course and programme outcomes. Every time teacher did necessary follow-up with an assigned task of students, and teachers illustrate the concept through examples and applications as reported by 38.5% and 58.2% students, respectively. As

conveyed by 45.5% students, teachers every time identified student's strength and encourage for right challenges, and 42.3% students reported that teachers help to overcome the weaknesses. The majority of the students (47.7%), agreed that the institute makes an effort to engage students in the monitoring, and 38.7% students opted that teachers use student centric methods for enhancing learning experiences. Also, 44.5% students strongly agreed that teachers encourage students to participate in extracurricular activities. The institute made effort to include soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make students ready for the world of work (37.8% students pointed). As reported by 16% students, more than 90% teachers use ICT tools for teaching. In addition, 43.6% students strongly agreed that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in the college is very good.
